### Services are provided by a personal assistant who may provide assistance with:

- Mobility in bed
- Transferring
- **Ambulation**
- Dressing
- Medication reminders
- Eating
- Toileting
- Personal hygiene
- **Bathing**
- Shopping
- Meal preparation
- Ordinary housework
- Laundry
- Managing finances
- Transportation (for work)

#### **Servicies not** provided include:

- Job coaching
- Reasonable accommodations
- Medical transportation or other benefits available via general Medicaid
- Other tasks not authorized on Care **Plans**

**EPAS** is not a waiver; there is no waiting list.

# **Employment-related Personal** Assistant Services (EPAS)

## What is EPAS?

EPAS is a Medicaid service for people with disabilities who work and need personal assistance in order to maintain their employment.

## Who is eligible for EPAS?

EPAS may be available to a person who:

- ✓ Has been determined to have a disability by SSI or the Medical Review Board
- ✓ Is gainfully employed in an integrated community. setting earning at least minimum wage
- ✓ Is currently working a minimum of 40 hours per month or is self-employed
- ✓ Needs personal assistance in order to maintain employment
